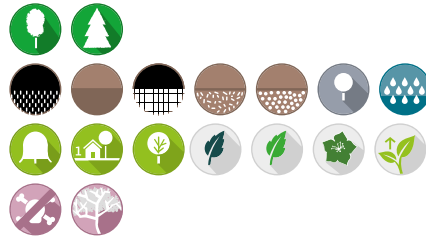




Sequoiadendron giganteum

'Pendulum'



Magasság	approx. 15 m
Szélesség	3-4m
Korona	broadly weeping, very irregular, light, open crown, capricious growing
Kéreg és ágak	reddish brown and soft, fibrous trunk, deeply grooved
Leaf	needles scaly and sharp, bluish green, 1 - 1.2 cm, evergreen
Virágok	unremarkable
Gyümölcsök	upright cones, hanging when ripe, reddish brown, 5 - 8 cm
Tüskés/tövíses	egyik sem
Mérgező tulajdonság	rendszerint nem mérgező emberek, (nagytestű) háziállatok és haszonállatok számára
Talajtípus	all, preferably very nutritious
Talajnedvesség	Nedves talajon használható

A conifer with a bizarre growth pattern, with branches hanging down sharply, but some growing in a more or less horizontal, undulating pattern. These branches have young, very thin twigs that hang straight down. The main trunk sometimes grows in a somewhat undulating fashion as well. This ultimately produces an exceptional, irregular growth pattern that is pre-eminently suited for solitary planting. The growth pattern is quite similar to that of the cultivar 'Barabits Requiem', however the branches of 'Pendulum' grow less far to the side. Height approx. 15 m and width 3 - 4 m. 'Pendulum' is slightly weaker than 'Barabits Requiem'. Trunk, branches, needles and cones are similar to those of the species. Requires protection against cold wind. Difficult to transplant.
