

A collection of 20 circular icons arranged in three rows. The first row has 10 icons: a green circle with a white flower, a black circle with a white grid, a brown circle with a white grid, a brown circle with a white grid, a brown circle with a white grid, a grey circle with a white flower, a blue circle with a white snowflake, a blue circle with a white cactus, a blue circle with a white flower, and a blue circle with a white flower. The second row has 6 icons: a green circle with a white house, a green circle with a white flower, a grey circle with a white leaf, a yellow circle with a white flower, a grey circle with the word 'May' in orange, and a green circle with a white flower. The third row has 4 icons: a brown circle with a white flower, a purple circle with a white flower, a purple circle with a white bird, and a brown circle with a white flower.

Usually a large, round shrub but eventually growing into a small tree. The twigs are initially purple, turning green-grey after 3 years. The drummondii variety is typified by its leaves, which are hairier and have a more elongated tip. The flowers are grouped in erect, umbel-shaped corymbs of about 8 cm. The individual flowers are small and yellowish white. They open in early summer. The berry-like fruits are pale blue to white. Grows wild in scrub, clay banks and thinly wooded areas, also in dry riverbeds. Tolerates a lot of water for a while.
